As a cousin, you are a descendant (or spouse of a descendant) of James Jones (1804-1895) who was a pioneer settler in Meade, Michigan. The James Jones Family Association continues to hold family reunions in Southeast Michigan each year on the 4th of July. We held our 171st reunion in 2024 with only one reunion missed since 1853. Reunion information is posted on the TJJFA website, the Facebook group, and emailed to addresses we have on file.

Due to the size of the association, postal mailing of newsletters and reunion notifications is no longer practical. The association will emphasize the use of email, Facebook and website-based communication going forward. Of the approximate 550 postal addresses we have on file, we only have about 130 valid email addresses, so we still have a lot of work to do getting cousin's email addresses.
